

Requirements

- ✓ EMBASSY OF GREECE IN PAKISTAN – CONSULAR SECTION
- ✓ DOCUMENTATION AND REQUIREMENTS FOR TOURISM/SHORT STAY VISA
- ✓ Passport, which must be valid for at least three months beyond the expiry date of the requested visa.
- ✓ Personal appearance and interview at the Embassy.
- ✓ Previous passports, if any.
- ✓ Two recent passport size photographs.
- ✓ Invitation, attested by the competent Police Authority in Greece, if you want to visit family or friends.
- ✓ If you are invited by your friend, a copy of the residence permit of your host in Greece if he/she is not a Greek national.
- ✓ If you are invited by a member of your family, official proof of relationship such as marriage or birth certificate as well as residence permit.
- ✓ Letter of reference issued by the company/organization/Government Service with which you are employed.
- ✓ Documents certifying that you have been given leave from your job/studies during the period you intend to visit Greece.
- ✓ Non-transferable return ticket to Greece (or reservation of it) that should be fully refundable only in Pakistan.
- ✓ Health Insurance
- ✓ Means of subsistence which should be proportionate to the length and purpose of visit and the cost of living in Greece and the Schengen state/s to be visited for the period of the stay. (Cash do not constitute substantial proof and are not accepted). More specifically:
 - Hotel reservation or full address of residence in Greece.
 - Proof of employment.

- In case of self-employment, official documents proving the ownership of property or business in Pakistan.
 - Genuine and updated bank statement, comprising the address and telephone number of the bank, undersigned by two bank officials.
 - Salary slips and income statement.
 - International insurance (minimum 30.000 euro) to cover possible accidents and hospitalization during the period of stay in the Schengen area.
 - Travel Cheque (optional).
 - Credit cards (optional).
- ✓ Following the adoption of the Resolution No 2006/440/EC of the council of the European Union, the processing fees for a Schengen visa (tourism, business, visit, transit) as of January 1, 2007, is 60 euros in local currency.
